Painting Rules & Procedures

In order to complete your community service and/or earn a certificate of completion for the Urban Arts Class/Projects you MUST complete the following:

- Signed Registration Form (w/parent signature if under 17 years of age)
- Painting Rules & Procedures
- Anti-Graffiti Law Worksheet

On days we paint you must fill out the **Paint Check In/Out** form to receive paint.

- All paint must be checked in/out by a TRUE Skool staff member
- If any paint cans you use are empty at the end of class, you still must return the cans to a staff member so you can check in the same number of cans you checked out at the end of the day.
- If you do not check in the same number of cans you checked out in the beginning of class you will not be able to paint the next class and if this repeats you can be expelled from the project and/or TRUE Skool.

It is VERY important that no student leaves TRUE Skool with ANY paint, caps, markers or any other supplies. TRUE Skool will not provide paint to anyone under 18 years of age unless it is being used in class or for projects which are supervised by TRUE Skool staff.
